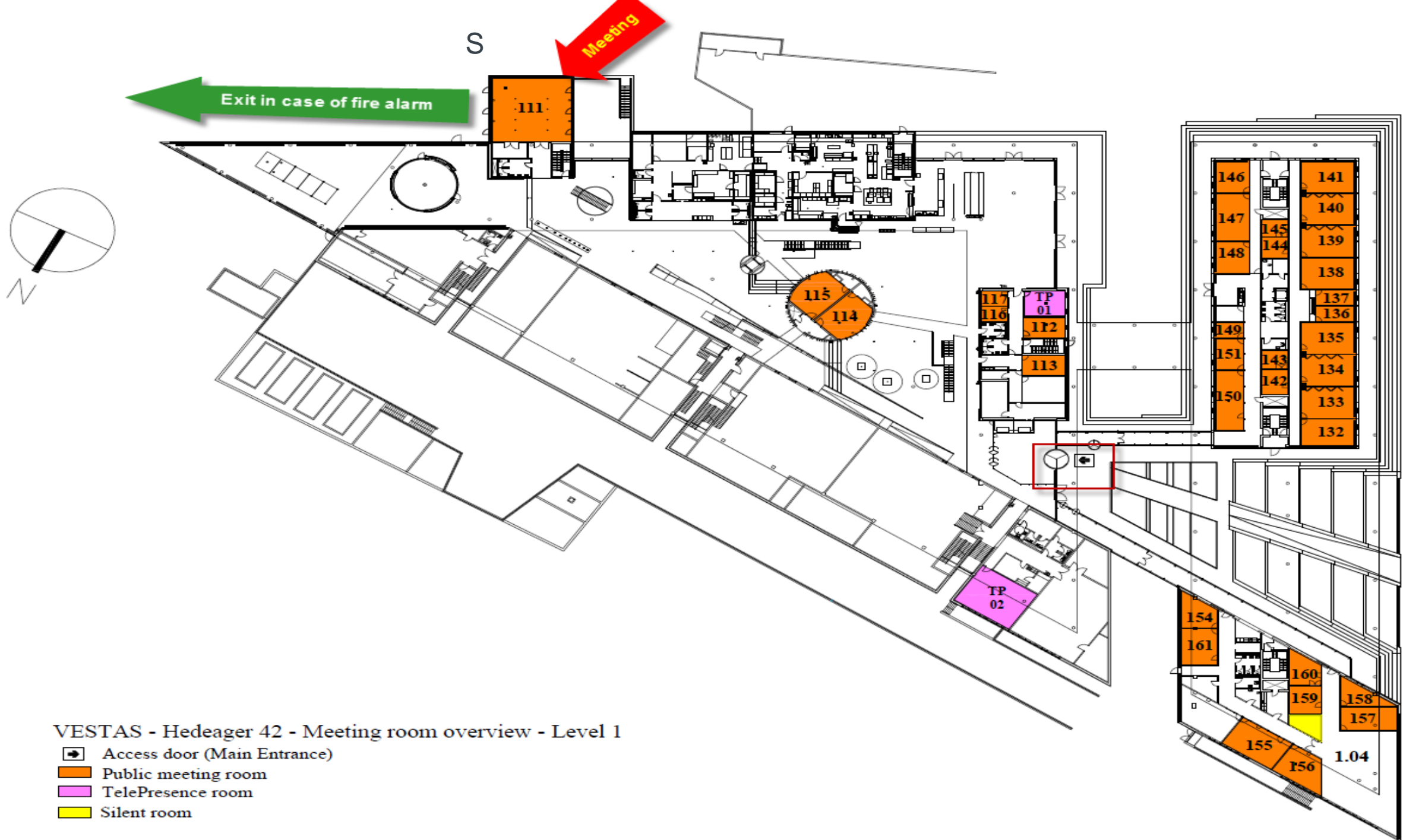

Continuous improvements through targeted efforts

Safety achievements

In 2011, Vestas begins tracking Total Recordable Injuries (TRI), which includes “restricted work injuries” and “medical treatment injuries” – providing greater insight for safety activities.

The incidence of total recordable injuries decreased from 5.3 per one million working hours in 2017 to 4.0 in 2018. The target for 2019 is 3.6
